Recommended Content Formats

- Fun and Entertaining Posts: Lighter content with a fun angle, like quizzes, memes, or virtual tour recommendations.

Writing Style

DO's:

- Clarity and Simplicity: Use everyday language to ensure readability.
- Conversational Tone: Write in a friendly, accessible style.
- Human Approach: Ask yourself, "Does this sound like something a person would say?"
- Short, Clear Sentences: Aim for sentences under 18 words to improve readability.
- Grammar and Punctuation: Ensure correctness, using tools if needed.



- Formatting: Use H2-H4 headings to divide content, spell out numbers under 10, and use % for percentages.
- Spelling and Grammar Check: Proofread to avoid errors; submissions requiring extensive edits may not be accepted.

DON'Ts:

- Avoid Jargon Overuse: Don't overload with technical terms unless explained for clarity.
- No Excessive Acronyms: Spell out terms on first use for reader clarity.
- Limit Filler: Avoid unnecessary information and long-winded explanations.
- Facts and Figures: Use statistics sparingly and only when they're directly relevant.
- No Keyword Stuffing: Write naturally; overly optimized content is not allowed.

Content Guidelines

- Posts should be at least 800 words.
- Content should focus on Metaverse, VR, AR, MR, AI, Blockchain, Web 3.0, and similar technologies.
- Structure your writing with clear headings and subheadings, and ensure it is grammatically correct.

Linking Policy

- Up to three relevant links that provide value and fit seamlessly within the content.
- Affiliate links, product/service pages, and social profiles are not allowed.
- Avoid keyword-stuffed anchor text; links should flow naturally within the context.

Media Guidelines

• Include images, videos, or graphics to illustrate your story. Only use media you own or available under a Creative Commons license, and credit all sources properly. Meta Enthusiasts reserves the right to modify or replace them as needed for aesthetics and branding.

Call to Action (CTA)

• Allow 1-2 weeks for review. Approved posts may require an invoice for fees. Avoid inquiries about submission status via email.
